A lovely French Chardonnay, with typical creamy texture, slight citrus and honey notes and none of the heavy oaking often found in the cheaper Chardonnays £3.80 (175ml)..... £14.00

Santa Puerta Sauvignon Blanc

This is a great Chilean, Central Valley Sauvignon that punches above its weight. Dry, crisp fruit forward, wine with typical Sauvignon herbaceous character and an elegant, refreshing finish£4.20 (175ml).....£16.80

La Campana, Pinot Grigio

A lovely classic Pinot Grigio, easy drinking with notes of apples, citrus and pear, followed by a refreshingly dry Finish, perfect for light easy drinking.....£4.20 (175ml)..... £16.80

Altas Cumbres Viognier

Another popular bottle that we had to keep, this great bottle from an award winning Argentinean vineyard is a lovely rich buttery Viognier with classic apricot overtones£17.10

Tesch Unplugged Riesling

Fabulous example of modern-style dry Riesling from a new generation of German winemakers. Delicate floral qualities, slight Riesling oiliness and an intense minerality, which makes for a big favourite£19.50

Vavasour, Dry Riesling

Wow, this is good. A Gold medal winning dry Riesling from Vavasour in New Zealand, this is an excellent new world Riesling with a strong, complex, palate of lime, wild flowers and apples and a clean, long finish. Recommended£22.80

Emile Petit, Chablis

A great example of a classic top quality Chablis, from Jean Marc Brocard. A firm structure, with finely balanced minerality and wonderful citrus notes, culminating in a long dry finish a must for Chablis lovers.....£25.80

Grant Burge "Zerk" Semillon-Viognier

Another great wine from Grant Burge, we picked Semillon/Viognier as it boasts a rich, round and mouthfilling palate with fresh fruit flavours and hints of shortbread This is a beautifully balanced wine with fresh acidity which also lends generous length of flavour and a clean finish£28.50

Sancerre Sylvain Bailly

In the same way as our great example of a Riesling, this bottle from Sylvain Bailly shows how great Sancerre can be. Classic citrus flavours and great minerality make this elegance in a glass.£33.80

Puligny Montrachet 1er Cru

Fabulous wine from Domaine Phillippe Bouzereau in Meursault. The step up in price is rewarded with an impressive concentration and complexity and an elegant, fruity, spicy finish.£43.80

Pleno Tinto

Miolo Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon

A wonderful red wine from the southern end of Brazil, a country not known for great wines, but this may help. A good strong, dark wine with coffee and dark chocolate overtones. Worth a try£18.50

Racers and Rascals Pinot Noir

A great new world Pinot from the Yarra Valley in Australia. A pale, slightly rusty appearance belies fabulous ripe cherries and wild berries in a lovely soft, delicate and seductive wine you won't want to share!£18.50

Beaujolais Dom Chatelus

When did Beaujolais become unfashionable? Well, we love it and this great value-for-money wine is classy, light and summery, with strawberry and ripe cherry flavours£18.50

Cote du Rhone Chuslan

A powerful example of French Cote Du Rhone with complex and delicate toasty, smoky nose(y) and a surprisingly long and satisfying finish for your money£19.50

Lodi, Jewel Petite Sirah

A wonderful example of a modern Petite Sirah from California, this great wine has a wonderful dark fruit aromas of plum, blueberry and black cherry balanced with a hints of vanilla, leather and spices£19.50

Rioja Vega Crianza

A classic style of one of the most popular appellations. The tannins are supple and the palate provides dark berry fruit with a fragrant tobacco edge.....£19.50

Chianti Classico Castello Di Querceto

More Italian wine, with a top end Chianti. A score of 90 points from wine spectator (that's very high apparently) this has a classic bitter cherry quality in a concentrated flavour and structure with a long finish£24.80

Spiga

A great Spanish wine here that our suppliers dropped the price for considerably, which means good value for money for a wonderfully composed flavour structure, nice oaky tones and a smooth elegance to savour£35.00

Nuits St Georges 1er Cru Argillats - A. Michelot

Top dollar for a top level wine. From one of Burgundy's top producers, this Pinot combines subtle aromas with superb concentration, great depth and a seductive silky feel. Absolutely lovely and worth every penny£40.80
